## Title I Program Purpose

- Designed to help children meet high academic standards
- Provide supplemental instructional services to identified children
- Oldest and largest federal aid program to schools



## Van Dyke has a School Wide Program

- Designed to generate high levels of academic achievement in core academic areas for ALL students, especially those who are not meeting the State's academic content and achievement standards



## Van Dyke Program

- We receive a large portion of our school funding through Title I Program
- There are government requirements to the Title I Program

# Schoolwide Program Requirements

- Comprehensive needs assessment
- Schoolwide reform strategies
- Instruction by highly qualified teachers
- Attract highly qualified teachers to high needs schools





## Requirements continued

- Parent Involvement Plan
- Transition Plan
- Teacher participation in assessment decisions
- Timely additional assistance
- Coordination of services and programs

## Title I Van Dyke Programs

- Full Day Kindergarten partially funded through Title I
- Assistants in Kindergarten and in Computer lab
- Summer School programs – focus can vary by the year
- Bi-lingual program for ELL students



## Title I Van Dyke Programs cont.

- Waterford computer programs in grades K-2
- Curriculum Consultants in each elementary school
- Social Work services in each building
- Instruction materials to enhance curriculum



## Title I Van Dyke Programs cont.

- Technology Teachers in each building
- Technology equipment and upgrades



## Title I Budget

- The Title I budget for this year is \$1,266, 000
- Budget has been decreasing last few years due to economy
- This creates a challenge to continue to provide our quality programs and add additional services
